SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS MEDIA NOTES
Pittsburgh Pirates (75-52) at San Francisco Giants (56-71)

August 23, 2013
AT&T Park

TONIGHT'S GAME...The San Francisco Giants host the Pittsburgh Pirates tonight in the second game of this four game series...**RHP Charlie Morton** (4-3, 3.67) is slated to face **LHP Madison Bumgarner** (11-7, 2.87).

THE GIANTS...Lost a 10-5 decision last night and are now 1-3 on this seven game homestand against the Red Sox (1-2) and Pirates (0-1)...the Giants have lost four of their last five games and seven of their last 11...they've gone 9-12 this month and are 13-20 (.394) since the All-Star break.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS...Prior to tonight's game the Giants have placed **RHP Matt Cain** on the 15-day disabled list with a contusion on his right forearm...**RHP Yusmeiro Petit** has had his contract purchased from triple-A Fresno and has been added to the Giants' 25-man roster.

THE FIRST TIME...This is the first time in **Matt Cain's** big league career that he's been placed on the disabled list...in his nine years in a Giants uniform he had never missed a start due to injury and had been skipped in the rotation just once.

ON THE MOVE...Former Giants OF **Jeff Francoeur** has cleared unconditional release waivers and is now a free agent.

ON REHAB...OF **Angel Pagan** (left hamstring surgery) had his rehab assignment transferred from rookie-level Arizona to triple-A Fresno today...Pagan has gone 2-for-11 (.182) with three runs scored, one triple and two walks in four rehab games.

ON THE MOUND TONIGHT...LHP **Madison Bumgarner** is 1-1 with a 0.69 ERA (1er, 13.0ip) along with 17 strikeouts and just two walks in two career starts against the Pirates...he last faced them in 2011.

RUNS SCORED/ALLOWED...The Giants have been outscored by a 31-9 margin through their first four games of this seven game homestand.

PINCH ME...SF pinch hitters have recorded 33 RBI this year, the most by any team in the Majors, ahead of Arizona (27) and Cincinnati (27)...**IF Brandon Belt** paces the club with six pinch RBI followed by **OF Gregor Blanco** (5) and **C Hector Sanchez** (5).

CENTRAL ISSUES...The Giants are just 9-22 (.290) against opponents from the NL Central this season...that's the second-lowest winning pct. for any NL team against that division (Miami is 7-22, .241)...the Giants have played nine series against Central teams and have won just one of those, taking three of four from the Cubs in Chicago from April 11-14.

DOWN ON THE FARM...Giants prospect **IF Mark Minicuzzi** is having one of the best seasons of his professional career while playing for double-A Richmond...he's hitting .314 (133-for-424) with 29 doubles, nine homers and 64 RBI as the Squirrels are battling to earn a wild card spot in the Eastern League...Minicuzzi ranks second in the league in batting average and ranks third in both hits and doubles.

RUNS HARD TO COME BY...The Giants are averaging just 3.41 runs per game here at home this season, plating 225 runs in 66 games...that's the lowest average in the Majors...they've scored just two runs or fewer in 17 of their last 29 home games and since the All-Star break have averaged just 2.24 runs per game (47 runs in the last 21 home games).

RISPY BUSINESS...The Giants enter tonight's contest just 6-for-41 (.146) with runners in scoring position in their past five games...they are hitting .216 (36-for-167) as a team in these situations this month.

SERIES NOTES...San Francisco has lost six of their last eight games to the Pirates...the 10 runs scored by the Pirates last night marked the second-most they've ever scored here at AT&T Park (they plated 13 on Aug. 11, 2007).

BRANDON BELTING...**IF Brandon Belt** has hit .351 (26-for-74) with five doubles, three triples and five home runs in 21 games this month...his .351 average ranks as the ninth-highest in the NL...he's also fourth in slugging pct. (.703) and ninth in on-base pct. (.429).

ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE...The Giants are 32-34 (.485) here at AT&T Park this season...their home win pct. ranks as the fifth-lowest in the NL...SF enters tonight's action having lost 11 of their last 15 home games, 14 of their last 19, and 24 of their past 35...they have just one home series win in their last nine sets.

AT THE TURNSTILES...The Giants have sold out their last 230 regular season home games, dating back to Oct. 1, 2010...it's the longest active regular season home sellout streak in the Majors.

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

SF August 23, 1998 - **Barry Bonds** hits his 26th home run, the 400th of his career, off **Kirt Ojala** of the Marlins in the Giants' 10-5 victory...he thus becomes the first player in Major League history with more than 400 career home runs and 400 career stolen bases.

TONIGHT'S OUTING

- 24-year-old All-Star (2013) will be making his 26th start of the season.
- Has been the Giants' best and most consistent pitcher this season, going 11-7 with a 2.82 ERA (51er, 163.0ip) in 25 starts, 16 of which are quality outings...the Giants are 13-12 in his assignments, losing his last three and five of his last six.
- Has just one winning decision in his last six starts, going 1-2 with a 2.13 ERA (9er, 38.0ip).
- Has held left-handed batters to a .161 avg. against (22-for-137), the fifth-lowest figure among NL pitchers behind Francisco Liriano (.137), Mark Melancon (.140), Clayton Kershaw (.148) and Tyler Clippard (.152).
- Is holding the opposition to a .210 clip (21-for-100) with runners in scoring position, including a .122 mark (6-for-49) with runners in scoring position and two outs.
- Had 10 consecutive starts of 7.0-or-more innings from June 14-Aug. 7... it ended on Aug. 13 at Washington due to a rain delay...was the longest streak by a Giants pitcher since **Rick Reuschel** strung together 11 such outings from Aug. 17-end of the 1988 season.
- Ranks fourth among NL pitchers with a .199 opponents batting average against, sixth in ERA (2.82), tied for ninth with 157 strikeouts, and tied for 13th in wins (11).
- Last season no left-hander in the Majors allowed more stolen bases than Bumgarner (27)...in fact, his 27 stolen bases allowed were the fourth-most in the Majors...however, this season, opponents are just six of 13 in stolen base attempts off him and he has six pickoffs.

2013 STARTS (LAST THREE)

- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Sunday at Miami in the Giants' 6-5 loss...was touched for four runs (three earned) on five hits in 5.0 innings of work.
- Was hurt by a one hour and 17-minute rain delay in his start on August 13 against the Nationals in Washington...had allowed one run through 4.0 innings on 68 pitches before the delay...marked his shortest start all season.
- Was charged with his seventh loss of the season in his start vs. the Brewers on August 7 at AT&T Park, a 6-1 Giants loss...had tossed 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits before the Brewers plated four runs off him in the 8th.

ON SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE

- Has the 12th-lowest home ERA in the NL with a 2.40 figure (20er, 75.0ip)... however, hasn't had a home winning decision since July 6 vs. Los Angeles.

VS. PITTSBURGH

- Will face the Pirates for the third time in his career and for the first time since 2011, when he went 1-1 with a 0.69 ERA (1er, 13.0ip) against them in two starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: Tim Lincecum

- Is 6-13 with a 4.53 ERA (77er, 153.0ip) in 25 starts, with 11 of those being quality outings...has struggled in his last two starts, allowing 11 runs on 16 hits in 11.0ip...suffered the loss in his last outing vs. Boston on Monday in SF's 7-0 loss...threw 5.0 innings, allowing five runs on nine hits and four walks with four strikeouts.
- **vs. Pittsburgh:** Has posted a record of 1-3 with a 4.38 ERA (18er, 37.0ip) in six career starts against the Pirates...has logged 6.0 innings or more in four of those starts, with three quality outings...faced the Pirates on June 11 in Pittsburgh and was touched for four runs (2er) on seven hits and two walks in 4.2 innings.
